Inception

- At their 22nd Session the OAU Labour & Social Affairs Commission endorsed the recommendation of the African Decade
- Adopted by OAU Heads of State & Government
- At their 35th Session the OAU Heads of State & Government declared 1999-2009 - The African Decade for Persons with Disabilities
- May 2003 - African Regional Consultative Conference resolved to establish a Secretariat for the African Decade of Disabled Persons



Secretariat of the African Decade

- Designed development & Implementation Programme
- To be implemented by:
 - Government line Ministries & Departments
 - Disabled People's Organisations (DPOs)
 - Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs)
 - International Organisations including UN agencies,
 - AU specialised agencies
 - Individuals committed to full participation, equality & empowerment of persons with disabilities



Goals of the Decade

- Full participation, equality & empowerment of Persons with Disabilities
- To ignite & galvanize increased interest in the disability discourse
- To give greater impetus, focus, action & reflection on the cause of total inclusion
- To put disability & the concerns of the disabled within the development and human rights paradigm



Opportunities of the Decade

- For African States:
 - to contribute to efforts to improve the lives of persons with disabilities on the continent
 - to highlight the success made in terms of integrating disability at country level



Development Objective


To enhance the quality of life, full participation and empowerment of all categories of disability in all spheres of life through the implementation, at local, district, provincial, national and international levels, of objectives, principles and strategies outlined in the Continental Plan of Action (CPOA) for the Africa Decade of Disabled Persons (Africa Disability Decade Programme).



Key Activities

Capacity Building

The capacity of the Africa Disability Decade Programme Secretariat, Disabled People's Organisations, and Decade Steering Committee in selected countries enhanced

- Policy Formulation & Implementation
Capacity and ability of government to formulate and implement national policies, legislation and programmes that promote the full and equal participation of persons with disabilities in selected countries enhanced and strengthened





Lobbying & Advocacy Work

The Secretariat enabled to lobby and advocate for inclusive planning and implementation of disability programmes at regional and continental levels
